



Back wall to be planted with a fast growing climber such as Virginia creeper, Parthenocissus viticella or cinquefolia which would give summer green and autumn reds.

Existing tree - one tree is to be removed prior to work commencing as advised.

A Winchester Arbour is to be positioned as shown on a gravel base. To be painted with Cuprinol Garden Shades, Country Cream and Black Ash as shown in photograph, on discussion with client.

Spaced box balls give accents to the planted beds and add formal structure and winter interest. To be surrounded by shade tolerant plants such as Digitalis, Lunaria, Aquilegia, Centranthus, Aстранtia and Hosta to give a cottage garden feel.

Wall height 6m

Existing shed to be painted with Cuprinol shades and wires to be positioned to support climbers. Plants such as Rosa 'Madame Gregoire Staechelin', 'Gloire de Dijon', Clematis and perhaps Vitis.

Stepping stone pavers lead to the shed through the bed.

Circular bed to be planted with a mix of perennials & shrubs. Three rusted iron obelisks form the focus between the box balls and can be used to grow clematis and roses over the summer.

Wall height 3m

The north facing wall is to be set with wires and shade tolerant climbers to be grown to clothe the stone. Species such as Chaenomeles, Clematis armandii, Hydrangea peteolaris and Hedera will add colour and interest.

A small tree adds height and gives a dappled shade. Eg Sorbus cashmiriana, Prunus 'Tai Haku' or Amelanchier lamarckii

Existing pavers to be lifted and re-used in new terrace. A single stepping stone is to be left under the window box which can be re-planted with shade tolerant species such as box and white bussie lizzies

Existing shed

Works duration: 1.5 weeks
Garden Spend: £10,200

Gate to garden

Existing shrubs to be selectively kept and new shrub and perennial borders to be planted. Emphasis on spring colour and foliage pattern & texture will make the most of the shady site.

A semi-circular lawn is to be created using shade tolerant grass species to area shown.

Wall height 1.9m

A lavender hedge is to be planted on either side of the existing pathway. This will disguise the level changes and create a central focus to the garden. Stepping stone pavers surrounded by gravel are to be positioned as shown to allow access through to the lawns.

Existing manhole to be covered by planting within bed.

A small oval shaped lawn is created to make the most of the sunny space. A bench is flanked by two small trees eg Prunus 'Accolade', Malus 'Evereste' or Pyrus chanticleer and under-planted with perennials and shrubs.

Area around front door to be generally tidied, climbers pruned and if possible gas extractor to be replaced with a new grille. A small gravel cut out will allow for some planting.

Existing terrace to be extended to area shown to allow room for a small table & chairs. Pavers to be re-used and mixed with Indian sandstone to merge areas as much as possible. Gravel cut-outs allow climbers to remain and soften the space.

A gravel & planted herb area leads off from the terrace with stepping stone pavers allowing access. A planted urn or chimney pot creates a focus and a small tree is to be planted in this corner to add height and interest.

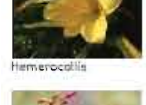

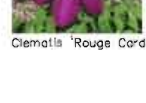
